


CHANGE.ORG – POLL BY YOUGOV SHOWS AUSSIES WANT CHANGE

A poll by YouGov, commissioned by [@future_super](#) for [@clothingthegaps](#), asked Aussies what they'd choose: a guaranteed January long weekend that never falls on January 26, or a public holiday fixed to January 26.
